1972 - Last U.S. Combat Unit Leaves South Vietnam - The last U.S. ground combat unit in South Vietnam, the Third Battalion, Twenty-First Infantry, departed for the United States. The unit had been guarding the U.S. air base at Da Nang. This left only 43,500 advisors, airmen, and support troops left in-country.

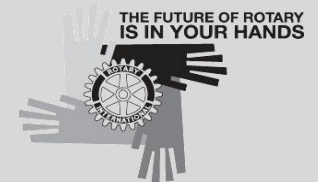
TRIVIA QUESTION
